

Copyright Filing & Requirement

According to Law No. 19 Year 2002 concerning Copyrights, Indonesia Copyrights Office operates a voluntary recordal system for copyright works. Recordal of a copyright work is prima facie evidence of subsistence and ownership of copyright. Actual and original evidence may still be required in any proceedings to enforce the copyright.

Generally applicant for copyrights registration in Copyrights Office receipt form author and/ or owner of Works such as computer program, Photography, motion picture (film), music industry, broadcasting and TV Program.

Filing requirements :

The following documents must be submitted in respect of each work.

1. Power of Attorney - signed by or on behalf of the applicant. No notarisation or legalisation required.
2. Declaration of Ownership - signed by or on behalf of the applicant. No notarisation or legalisation is required.
3. Deed of assignment of rights between author/creator and applicant.
4. Sample of works.

Note :

- Indonesian corporate applicants are also required to submit Articles of Association and each director's KTP (identity card).
- Indonesian individual applicants are required to submit their KTP.

Application procedure and time frame :

The registration procedure normally takes between 12 – 15 months from filing of the application.
